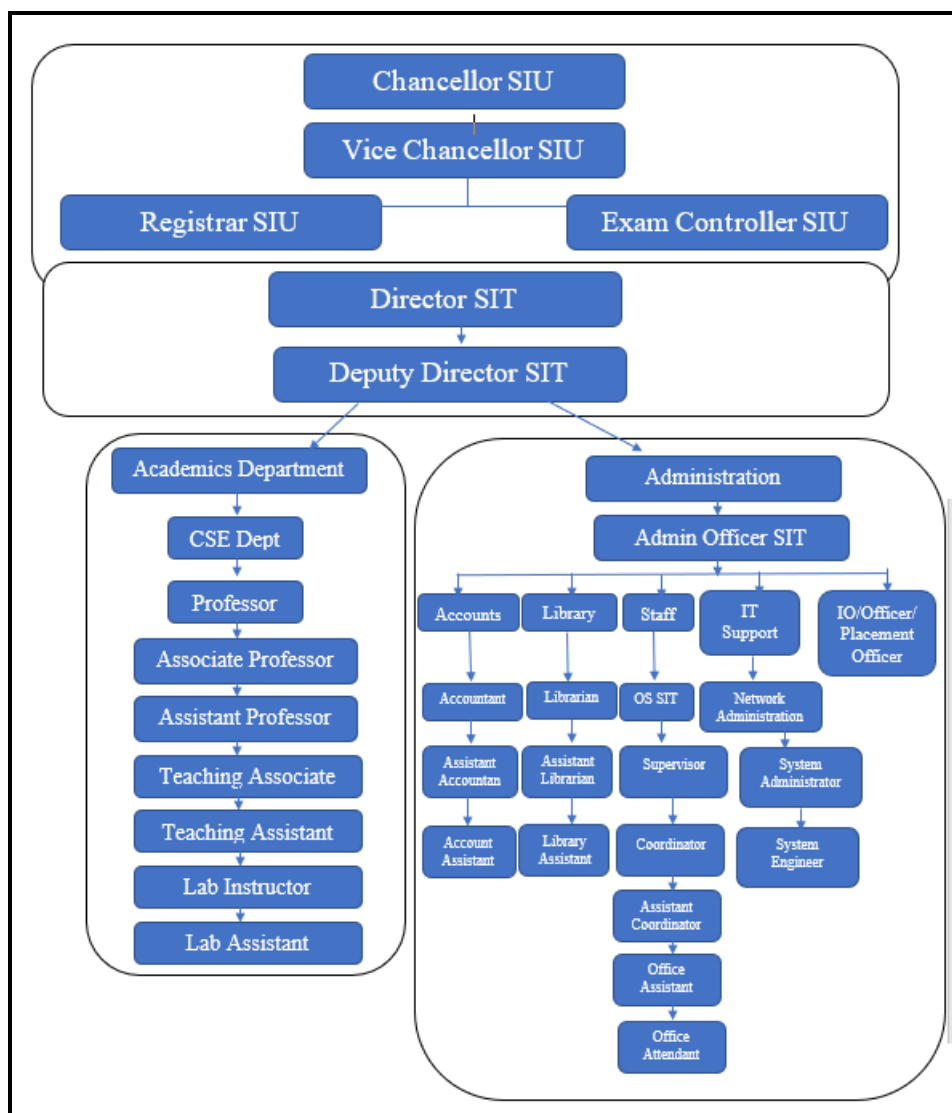

Nature and Extent of involvement of Faculty and students in academic affairs / improvements:

Following initiatives are carried out for faculty and students:

Faculty:

- Financial assistance is provided to the faculties for publications.
- Use of laboratories are extended to faculty as required.
- Funding is provided to the faculty to implement their research project. More experienced faculty are encouraged to apply for research grants from various Government and Non-Government, research funding agencies such as UGC, AICTE, MHRD, DST etc.
- Collaborative research partnerships with academic institutes and industry are encouraged.
- Assistance is provided for filing patents and the patents are fully funded by the Institute.
- The Industry Institute Interaction Cell (IIIC) works in close coordination with the industries and the institute for encouraging both students and faculty to work on live projects. The departmental industry coordinator who interacts with the industries by approaching local industries, to understand their expectations in terms of knowledge and skill requirements in a graduating engineer. IIIC, as part of the quality improvement strategy and to bridge the gap between academics and industry. Regular interaction with the industries is established through meetings, guest lectures, hands-on training sessions, internships, projects and industrial visits. Obtain industry-sponsored final year projects
- An initiative is taken by Library to help researchers in understanding recent updates of their publications in terms of citation index etc.

- In-house development of both lab equipment and software's is carried out on a regular basis.
- SIT believes that faculty and staff are the back bones of the institute and that its success depends on the quality of human resources. Therefore, the objectives of the human resource development department are focused on maximizing employee performance. Priority is given to train them to meet their teaching objectives, helping them realize their potential, counsel low-performing faculty based on their feed, back and appreciating the faculty showing excellent work the academic tenure.
- Training is arranged for teaching as well as nonteaching staff by identifying training needs, for enhancing professional competencies, teaching and soft skills · Service rules are transparent and benefits like Provident Fund, Gratuity, Group Insurance Scheme, Medclaim etc. are provided to employees.
- The institute arranges financial planning lectures for staff, to assist them for effective planning of their finances
- The institute arranges lectures for staff, to assist them for effective stress management and health, regular health check-up facility is made available.
- Institute implements a variety of welfare schemes for teaching and non-teaching staff like Medclaim Policy, Group Insurance, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Fee concession etc.

Students:

- Project Based Learning course is introduced in which a group of 3 to 4 students identify the problem and work on it as a small project. It can be called a mini project. Students can contact the faculty member to understand the problem. Apart from PBL few more courses like Tinker lab, Creative thinking Critical thinking, Design Thinking, Entrepreneurship venture, and Capstone courses have been introduced from the first year till final year B. Tech students. A provision of Flexi courses, which can be designed just before the start of the semester based on the current technological demand is made available.
- Curriculum is revised as per requirements and needs.
- The alumni representative is a member of Quality Improvement cell (QIC) the suggestions received from alumni are invited and incorporated as required in the curriculum.
- To identify and invite industry experts to deliver content beyond syllabus and make students aware of contemporary issues and engineering practices adopted in the industry
- To provide industry exposure to students through internships in industry, industry visits and enable them to pick up skills besides what is being imparted in the classrooms. In autonomous structure students are allowed to undergo semester wide internship program industry-sponsored final year projects
- Service Learning: The institute believes that we have a responsibility towards society hence Service Learning is a mandatory subject for the students, so that the students can become responsible towards society, environment, global issues, etc. and develop into responsible citizens. The Symbiosis International (Deemed University) SIU launched the Symbiosis Community Outreach Programme and Extension (SCOPE) on 2nd July 2012 with the objective of positively impacting the community around SIU as a part of its health promoting initiatives. SCOPE through its twin arms of healthcare and non-health initiatives is working towards a sustainable, comprehensive and integrated development of the 22 identified villages located in the vicinity of main campus of SIU at Mulshi taluka of Pune district. The objective is to equip the community to identify, and promote its own health initiatives, by taking proactive, community driven sustainable socio-economic and environmental efforts. SIU is committed to the principles of — 'Health for All' and sustainable development. This is an asset to the university staff, students and to the communities in which they are located and to the wider society where these students will eventually assume professional roles.
- Membership of different professional bodies have been taken for students which can help the students to grow beyond class rooms.
- Training & Placement Cell also fosters relations with the industries as a part of the placement drive. In order to understand industry needs the cell hosts an HR meet every year. The meet involves

lectures/interactions with eminent industrialists, panel discussions between students, faculty and industry experts which gives valuable insights of the placements scenario and recent developments at local and global levels that serve as an input for identifying training needs of our students in order to make them employable.

- Training is provided to each student regarding Certificate in Covid-19 Care for community by SUHRC.
- Sport facility/students affairs/improvements Students are motivated for the participation in different curricular/ co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
- Health check-ups and medical facilities are available for all the students.
- Different events; tech fest, reverb, hackathon, literary club, departmental club, student's chapters are carried out throughout a year.

Mechanism/Norms and Procedure for democratic/good governance:

The management recognizes the need for decentralization for the growth of the institute and accords autonomy commensurate with the level of management. Dean, Director, Deputy Director Academics, Deputy Director Administration, Heads of the department, Examination head, In-charge Internationalization, In-charge Industry Connect, Placement Officer, in-charge Quality Assurance Cell, Librarian, Administrative officer, In-charge Mentoring Cell are appointed for efficient governance. The roles and responsibilities of administrator's/decision makers for various assigned jobs listed below clearly depict the delegation of authority, providing operational autonomy leading to a decentralized governance system.

- Dean, to initiate research activities, new programmes, monitoring the overall progress of the institute
- Director, to implement and monitor the education system to cater to the institute's vision and mission.
- Deputy Director Academics, is responsible for academic development, curriculum structure design for all courses and monitor progress of various teaching/learning processes. To organize different academic meetings every semester.
- Deputy Director Administration, is to monitor all administrative and operational functions in the institute
- Head of the department, is responsible for the academic and administrative functions of the department.
- In-charge Quality Assurance cell, is responsible for preparing towards different accreditations like NBA and NAAC and comply with various ranking agencies such as NIRF, OMPI etc.
- Examination Head, is responsible for planning and conduction of all internal / end semester examination, coordination and generation of result.
- In-charge Internationalization, is responsible for international exposure to the institute.
- In-charge Mentoring Cell, is responsible for counselling and monitoring the progress of the students, communicating the same to their parents.
- Administrative Officer, is responsible for all administrative activities, finance, annual budget, admissions, social gathering of students.
- In-charge Industry connect, is responsible to connect with Industries in and around Pune for semester wide internships, sponsored projects, providing industry experts in different academic activities and forming and implementing MOU's.
- Placement officer, is responsible for placement of the students.
- Librarian, is responsible for maintaining the library resources, making offline/ online books/ journals/ articles available for faculty and students.
- At the department level:
 - Each program has Coordinator for undergraduate and post-graduate programs.
 - Based on the institute calendar proposed by Deputy Director Academics, the department calendar is prepared for planning and organizing of various activities in the department
 - Each course has a course coordinator who, in consultation with the faculty teaching the subject, sets course objectives, prepares the teaching plan for the semester, conducts meetings with faculty regularly to monitor and review course completion and attainment of course outcomes.
 - Class teachers/batch mentor are designated for all classes/batches Students.

Feedback on Institutional Governance/Faculty Performance:

1. Feedback on curriculum from all the stakeholders; Alumni, students, industry, parents and faculty is collected every year and the analysis is used in development of curricula for the next academic year.
2. Feedback about Faculty is taken from students twice a semester.
3. The various parameters on which teaching is assessed are Communication Skills, Quality of Teaching/ Academic input, Subject Knowledge, Content and Method of Delivery, Resourcefulness, Readiness of teacher, Accessibility and Availability of Teacher in Campus/ Department. Based on the analysis of it, the counselling of the faculty having feedback less than 3.5(out of 5) is carried out and the appreciation letter to faculty having feedback more than 4.5 is given.
4. An Institute Level Parent Teacher meeting is conducted once every semester. During the meeting, parents are made aware about their wards' attendance, academic performance for the semester as well as about the various learning processes conducted in the institute. During the pandemic situation the Parent-teacher meeting was conducted online and the response to the meet was overwhelming.
5. Feedback about Institute is also taken from all students once in a year. This includes the feedback about the facilities and the infrastructure of the institute. In year 2021-22 the classes were conducted online and the feedback was modified accordingly.
6. Various companies will visit the campus of the institute for the placement of the students. Based on this feedback, Guest lectures, workshops, seminars are organized for students to help them to be ready for industry.
7. Internal Continuous Evaluation System and place: Examination Scheme (ES) The Examination Scheme shall be based on a yearly bi-semester pattern for both UG and PG Programs. Course contents (syllabi), for the courses, are as recommended by the Board of Subjects (BoS) and approved by the Academic Council (AC) and by Board of Management (BoM). The structure and courses taught for UG are as detailed in the relevant section, in this manual, on Academic Rules and Regulations. The same can also be accessed on the college website (www.sitnagpur.edu.in).
8. Assessment of Academic Performance for both UG program the evaluation of a candidate, for the academic performance in a course, shall be based on the performance in continuous assessment (CA), and End Semester examinations (ESE).
9. Continuous Assessment (CA): This is conducted by the course teacher throughout the semester and shall include evaluation of laboratory work, assignments, problem solving, group discussion, quiz, seminar, mini-project and other academic tools of evaluation. The course teacher shall announce the detailed methodology, for conducting the various component of CA together with their weightages, in the beginning of the semester.
10. End Semester Examination (ESE): It is conducted at the end of semester, being subjective but this year it was conducted in online mode due to pandemic using Microsoft Team and google classroom. Monitoring of Evaluation CA shall be conducted by the course teacher and monitored by the Head of department. ESE shall be conducted by the Examination Section and monitored by Examination head.
11. Rules of Passing: The minimum passing percentage in each course (Theory, CA, Practical/ seminar/ project/ internship) is 40% (grade P) To earn credits for a course
12. (Theory/practical/oral/seminar/project/internship), the candidate must pass the course with minimum passing marks/grade ($\geq 40\%$ / $> F$ Grade)

Student feedback mechanism on Institutional Governance/faculty performance**• Feedback at SIT:**

- Feedback is an integral part of academics at Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT) and is conducted each semester for each and every course using the LMS Module, an online module for conducting all types of feedback and designed specifically for all institutes affiliated with Symbiosis International (Deemed University). Feedback aids in the improvement of the teaching-learning process and benefits both students and faculty in various ways.

- Curriculum feedback is collected every semester and analysed separately from various stakeholders such as students, alumni, industry experts, parents, and faculty. The only exception is the Student Satisfaction Survey, which is conducted once a year at the end of the even semester
- **Students Response to feedback:**
 - Students enables to enter the feedback once it is activated successfully in LMS portal.
 - The students enter the feedback in LMS with their Login ID and Password. The feedback is enable through mobile, Laptop, or desktop. The feedback can be entered any time during the time for which it is active.
 - The LMS provides a list of students who have submitted feedback and a list of remaining students. The remaining students are sent reminder through email to submit the feedback in scheduled time.
 - The Feedback process is confidential and executed with the control of Deputy Director Academics and the Director of the institute. The feedback coordinator is assigned to monitor and regulate the feedback.

Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

1. The Grievance Committee has been formed as per the guidelines of the SIU and it deals with the grievances of the teachers and other staff. Faculty and staff members can approach Head of Department and Director for redressal of any grievance. Suggestion boxes are checked on a weekly basis and action taken reports are notified to the students, even to anonymous suggestions/complaints.
2. Students, in case of any problem with teaching can contact their head of department. They can also report the matter to the Director. The action is taken in stipulated time frame.
3. In addition, various committees of students have been formed. Mess committee meets the Admin Officer and Director regularly. There is a student consultation committee. Meeting is held regularly. Action is taken on the points raised by the students and reported in the next meeting.
4. Generally, faculty feels comfortable to talk about the indifferences to mentors/Heads of Departments or Director. The actions are immediate in consultation with all concerned since the policies have been properly laid down, conflicts are totally avoided.



Project Based Learning course is introduced in which a group of 3 to 4 students identify the problem and work on it as a small project. It can be called as mini project. Students can contact the faculty member to

understand the problem. Apart from PBL few more courses like Tinker lab, Creative thinking Critical thinking, Design thinking, Entrepreneurship venture and Capstone courses have been introduced from first year till final year B. Tech. students. A provision of Flexi courses, which can be designed just before the start of the semester based on the current technological demand is made available.

Curriculum is revised as per industry requirement and needs.

The alumni representative is a member of Quality Improvement cell (QIC) the suggestions received from alumni are invited and incorporated as required in the curriculum.

To identify and invite industry experts to deliver content beyond syllabus and make students aware of contemporary issues and engineering practices adopted in the industry.
