Late Jayatee Deshmukh Scholarship (for SNAP/ SET female toppers)

Late Jayatee Deshmukh Scholarship (for SNAP/ SET female toppers)

Preamble:

The Scholarship is awarded in memory of Late Ms. Jayatee Deshmukh, a former student of Symbiosis International (Deemed University). It is funded by her family and administered by Symbiosis International (Deemed University). This scholarship is provided exclusively to the female candidate who top university entrance test for its PG and UG programmes.

Introduced with effect from: Academic Year 2011-2012

Awarded to:

- i. Female topper of the Post Graduate Entrance Examination for MBA Symbiosis National Aptitude Test (SNAP) and who secures admission to any MBA programme of Symbiosis International (Deemed University).
- ii. Female topper of the Undergraduate Entrance Examination Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET/SLATSITEEE/SEED) who secures admission to any under graduate programme of Symbiosis International (Deemed University).
- iii. The student will not be eligible for the award of this scholarship, if there is any disciplinary case against her.

Number of Scholarships = Two (2)

Amount of Scholarship for a Post Graduate Candidate = One-time payment of Rs.75,000/-

Amount of Scholarship for an Undergraduate Candidate = One-time payment of Rs. 25,000/-

(I) Eligibility/ amount of scholarship to a Post Graduate Candidate:

- i. The scholarship will be given to a girl student securing the highest marks in SNAP test and admitted to MBA programme.
- ii. The one-time scholarship amount of Rs.75,000/- would be paid to the Constituent where the student gets admission and the amount would be adjusted against the second instalment of fee.
- iii. In case a student is eligible for more than one scholarship / free ship by Symbiosis Society Foundation, she shall be awarded only one scholarship / free ship as per her preference.
- iv. In case the topper does not avail this scholarship, it will be given to the next eligible candidate.

(II) For an Undergraduate Candidate:

- i. The scholarship will be given to a girl student securing the highest percentage in SET/SLAT/SITEEE /SEED and admitted to any undergraduate programme.
- ii. The one-time scholarship amount of Rs. 25,000/- will be paid to the Constituent where the student gets admission and the amount will be adjusted against the second instalment of fees.
- iii. In case a student is eligible for more than one scholarship / free ship by Symbiosis Society Foundation, she shall be awarded only one scholarship / free ship as per her preference.

Process:

The Department of Student Welfare will collect data of the SNAP, SET/SLAT/SITEEE/SEED female toppers every year from the Symbiosis Test Secretariat.

The data will be verified by the Eligibility Section

Finance Department of the University shall check whether the academic fees are paid by the students.

The data will be sent to the Constituent for confirming the status of admission and certifying that the candidate does not have any disciplinary case against the student.

Selection:

(I) For a Post Graduate Candidate:

- i. Department of Student Welfare will nominate five (5) highest scoring Female SNAP toppers based on the list of Female toppers received from the Symbiosis Test Secretariat and seek approval for the top scorer from the University Authorities.
- ii. Constituents will be informed about the final nominees.

(II) For an Undergraduate Candidate:

- i. Department of Student Welfare will nominate five (5) highest scoring Females SET/SLAT/SITEEE & SEED toppers based on the list of Female toppers received from the Symbiosis Test Secretariat and seek approval of the Vice Chancellor the nominated 5 highest scoring females.
- ii. Constituents will be informed about the final nominees.

Tie breaker:

(I) For a Post Graduate Candidate:

If two or more girl students tops the SNAP with equal scores, then the student with the higher score in GE-PIWAT will be considered for the scholarship.

If there is tie at the GEPIWAT level also, then the score of UG programme will be considered for the award of this scholarship.

(II) For an Undergraduate Candidate:

If two or more girl top the SET/SLAT/SITEEE/SEED with equal scores, then the weighted average of their Std. X and Std. XII class grades will be considered for a tie breaker and the highest scorer will be the final nominee.

Disbursement of scholarship:

The Scholarship amount will be paid to the Constituents and they in turn, will adjust the amount in the Second instalment of fees, to be paid by the student.

Scholarship cessation / withdrawal:

- i. If the selected student cancels her admission, before completion of the programme, then the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will have to return the previously disbursed Scholarship amount* to the University. (discuss with FO Madam)
- ii. If the selected student cancels her admission before selection or opts to withdraw her name from the nomination list, then the next eligible girl student gets that Scholarship. If the scholarship is awarded and student cancels her admission in that case, it will not be awarded to the next student.
- iii. If a recipient of the Scholarship is found guilty of gross misconduct then the name of the recipient shall be reported by the Constituent to the Department of Student Welfare for withdrawal of the scholarship.
- iv. If the student is eligible for any other SIU Scholarship which is more preferable, the student may withdraw her name from the Nomination list and the next eligible student will nominated for the scholarship.

*In case the student does not repay, the University shall have the right to recover the said disbursed amount from the security deposit, hostel fees, mess fees etc.
