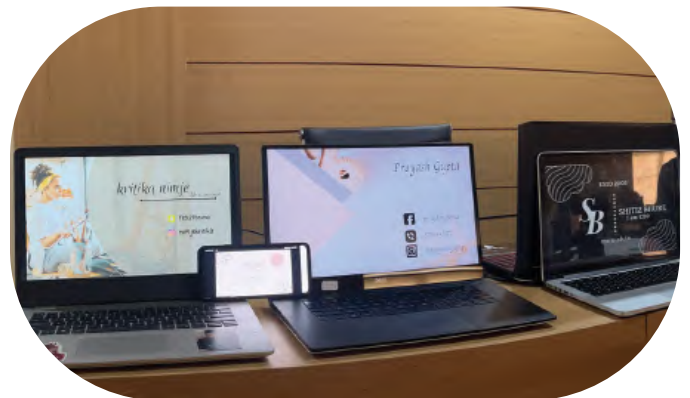
All about GitHub

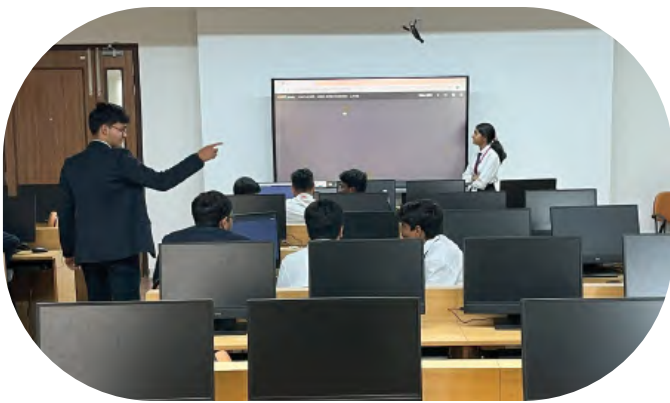

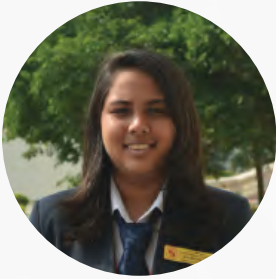
